H.R. 927 – Condemning the Trump Administration's Zero Tolerance Policy (Introduced and agreed to in the House on June 17, 2018) https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/house-resolution/927/	Condemns separating children from their parents at the U.S. border, identifies as child abuse, and recognizes that this may inflict irreversible damage to health of these children, remains committed to keeping parents and children together, most of whom are fleeing violence.
S.2937 – Help Separated Children Act (Introduced May 23, 2018) https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/senate-bill/2937/	This Act may be cited as the "Humane Enforcement and Legal Protections for Separated Children Act" or the HELP Separated Children Act". Definitions of "child" and "adult" are included.
H.R. 6136 – Border Security and Immigration Reform Act of 2018 (Introduced June 21, 2018) https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/house-bill/6136	Postponed until a time is announced.
Executive Order – Affording Congress an Opportunity to Address Family Separation (Promulgated June 20, 2018) https://www.whitehouse.gov/presidential-actions/affording-congress-opportunity-address-family-separation/	All while keeping strict the laws on illegal immigration, families will not be separated.

Right to Try Act of 2017 (Became Public Law May 30, 2018)

This multi-faceted bill amends the Truth in Lending Act and the Federal Deposit Insurance Act. It protects veterans, consumers, and homeowners; it revises previous programs to give employment and savings incentive programs for families that reside in public housing and other financial protections

This Bill establishes national standards and rules by which terminally ill patients may be provided with investigational drugs.

H.R. 5515 – National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (Introduced April 13, 2018) https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/house-bill/5515/text	To authorize for Fiscal Year 2019 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and other purposes. Contains a report on personal protective equipment requirements for civil response teams to volcanic activity, Subtitle D, Section 336 and a Contains a report on wildfire suppression capabilities of active and reserve components, Subtitle D Reports Sec.337
H.R. 3 – Spending Cuts to Expired and Unnecessary Programs Act (Latest Action June 20, 2018) https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/house-bill/3	This bill rescinds approximately \$15 billion in budget authority over 2018-2028 that was proposed to be rescinded by the President. If Congress does not pass rescission legislation within 45 days of continuous session of Congress, the President must make the funds available. See Summary and Text of this Bill for definition of rescission and a list of specified programs and accounts.
