<p>H.R. 2157 (116th Congress) Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2019 <i>(Signed into Law on June 6, 2019)</i> https://www.congress.gov/bill/116th-congress/house-bill/2157</p>	<p>This bill provides \$17.2 billion in FY2019 supplemental appropriations to several federal departments and agencies for expenses related to the consequences of recent wildfires, hurricanes, volcanoes, earthquakes, typhoons, and other natural disasters</p>

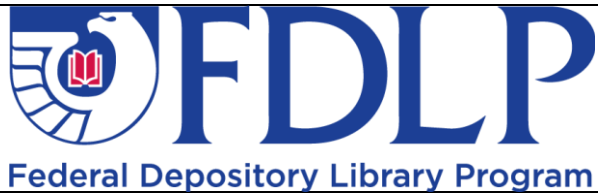
