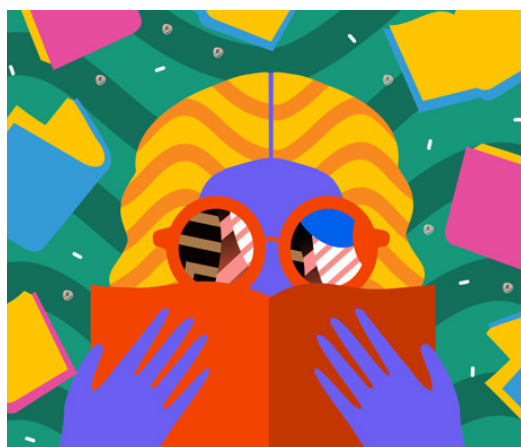


## Changes on Ferguson Library Board

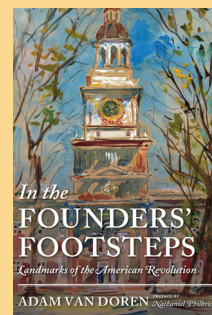
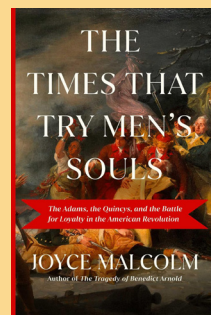
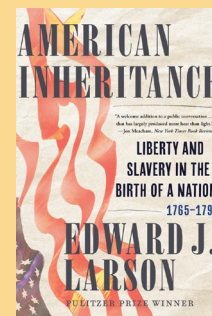
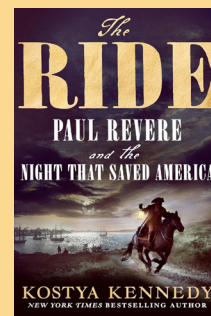
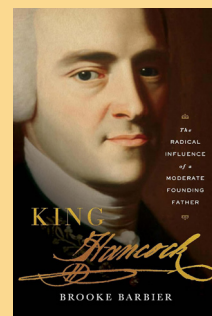
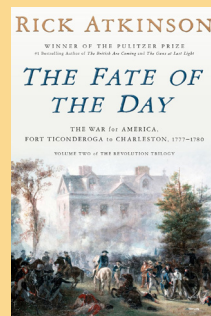
### Stamford Connect
